ABPM Tutorial – Retrieving Results


(Please note - these instructions should be followed after the patient testing has been completed.)

Step 1. The ABPM test must be stopped first. This can be done by removing the batteries from the ABPM.

Step 2. Connect the ABPM to your PC using the provided USB cable
